Cheryl Duckworth

Cheryl Duckworth, Ph.D., is a professor of Conflict Resolution at Nova Southeastern University.

Dr. Duckworth has trained hundreds of students, teachers and community leaders in peace education and conflict resolution both in the US and internationally. Currently, she serves as the faculty advisor of NSU's Peace Education Working Group and on the Advisory Board of the Hope Development Organization, a women's rights and peace building organization in Pakistan, and Women's Promise, which advocates for and empowers women's leadership for peace globally.

Dr. Duckworth has published and presented globally on her two passions, peace education and peace economics, exploring ways to transform the economic, political, social and psychological root causes of war and violence. Most recently, she published Teaching About Terror: 9/11 and Collective Memory in US Classrooms, which analyzes the narrative today's students are receiving about 9/11, and the implications of this for global peace and conflict.

Please join us on this historic anniversary to hear Dr. Duckworth's perspectives and experience on the efforts to create a more peaceful world.

Grand Opening Celebrations Kick Off with Media/VIP Night September 13, 2017



The Art and Culture Center has been selected to host the 2017 South Florida Cultural Consortium from September 9 through October 22, 2017. The opening reception will take place on September 8 from 6-9 pm. The exhibition, titled Dual Frequency, will feature interdisciplinary work from 14 preeminent South Florida artists selected to receive awards in 2017 of either \$15,000 or \$7,500. These awards are among the largest such honors accorded by local arts agencies to visual and media artists in the United
