


Mary C. Owens, MSW, CDC, CTACC

Young At Art Museum hosts the 14th Annual Recycled Fashion Show Friday, November 15 from 7 - 11 p.m. Talented teen designers will showcase their original couture fashions made from sustainable, recycled materials in a New-York-style fashion show titled *Artists Restyled*. Each teen has chosen a ground-breaking artist on which to base her designs. Participants in YAA's fashion fundraiser are teens in YAA's Volunteer Program and YAA's Girls N' Power Program at PACE Center Broward: 100 percent of the net proceeds from the fashion show benefit YAA's community

initiatives serving low-income children, families and at-risk teen girls.

On October 11th, the Broward County Women Lawyers' Association (BCWLA), the Broward County School Board, Hispanic Vote and members of the judiciary of the 17th Judicial Circuit, hosted more than 80 students at the courthouse for an Informed Voters Workshop. BCWLA Vice-President and BWA President-Elect Vivian Fazio, made a presentation to the students on the role of judges in the court system, what attributes to look for, and how essential it is to our democracy that judges be fair and impartial.
